

Parking Locations

The City of Naples offers many public beach access points to the Gulf of Mexico along 9 miles from Clam Pass to Gordon Pass with Doctors Pass in between. The beach access points have parking directly adjacent to the beach access. From the North to the South they include:

- Via Miramar Beach** - From US 41 in the Moorings, head west on Harbour Drive, Left on Gulf Shore Blvd N to Via Miramar.*

Parking Ticket Fines

A handicap ticket violation fine is \$250 all other violation fines are \$100. Both types of tickets have a \$2 surcharge added for sole purpose of funding the school crossing guard program, therefore the total cost for a handicap parking violation is \$252 and the total cost for all other parking violations is \$102. Timely payment of a parking fine (excluding a handicap violation) will reduce the cost of the ticket. The chart below will assist you with the fines/surcharge total cost.



Total Ticket Cost	Payment Timeframe	Reduced Fine
\$102	Less than 10 days	\$37
\$102	Greater than 10 days and less than 60 days	\$47
\$102	Greater than 60 days	\$102

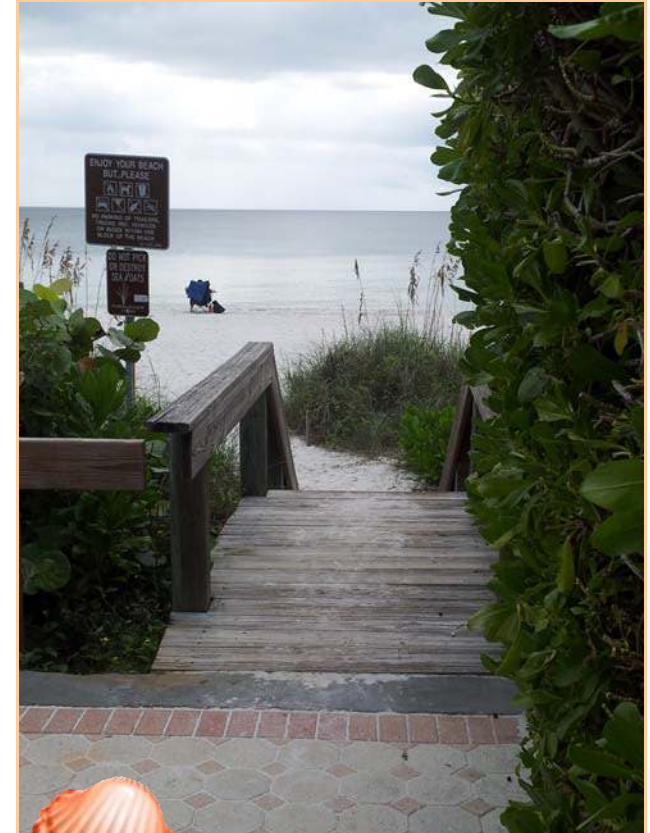

Obtaining a Beach Parking Permit

All Collier County property taxpayers and full-time residents are eligible to receive an annual permit to park at all City of Naples and Collier County beaches free of charge.

Residents of the City of Naples may obtain their free annual beach parking permit by visiting City Hall at 735 8th Street South. Residents must provide proof of residency, specifically, a drivers license and original vehicle registration, both with the same name and address within the City limits. Non-residents who own property in the City limits must provide a copy of their Collier County tax statement reflecting an address in the City limits, as well as their current drivers license and vehicle registration.

Non-residents can purchase an annual City Beach Parking Permit for \$50. These stickers are ideal for non city/non county residents or non city/non county property owners who are visiting and wish to park at the city or county beaches without paying an hourly or daily fee.

Collier County residents (outside the City limits) can obtain their free Collier County Beach Parking Permit at most of the Collier County Community Parks.



Permit Placement

Beach parking permits must be firmly affixed to the inside of the windshield in the lower corner of the driver's side of the vehicle. They are not transferable. Vehicles with valid beach permits may park free of charge in metered spaces at City and County beaches, beach ends of City streets, and in any space designated as requiring a beach permit.



Beach parking permits are valid for one year only. Observe the month that is punched on your beach parking sticker, and remember to replace the permit before the month ends.

Beach Parking Rules



All of the parking areas have signs to assist visitors in understanding the parking rules.

Beach Parking Rules:

- ALL unmetered parking spaces require a beach parking permit.
- ALL metered parking spaces require payment or beach parking permit.
- Please help keep your beach clean-no littering.
- No glass, animals, or fires allowed on the beach.
- No parking of trailers, trucks, recreational vehicles or buses within one block of the beach. **Violators will be towed at owner's expense.**

Parking Meters

All beach ends in the City have multi-space parking pay stations for customers that do not have a beach parking permit. Parking is not free it is \$2.50 an hour.



These machines are conveniently located near the entrance to the parking area or beach access point.

They accept coins and American Express, Discover, VISA, and MasterCard.

Every six minutes of parking costs \$.25, or a total of \$2.50 per hour. A minimum of \$1.25 is required. When you exit your vehicle, make a note of your parking space number, you will need to enter that number into the parking machine.

Once you type your parking space into the pay station and the screen will display the time your payment will expire.



You can also **Extend-by-Phone** by adding your cell phone number at the conclusion of your transaction.

This will notify you 10-15 minutes prior to the expiration of your meter and will allow you to extend your meter's time, to avoid any

parking violation.

You can not renew time after the meter has expired.
